

LIST OF REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR FMP SUBMITTALS

"FMP" stands for "Flood Mitigation Project" and represents an initiative that helps to reduce or eliminate flood risk to life and property. TWDB requires that FMPs be supported by a study prior to an FMP being submitted and that significant information is readily available.

To support an **FMP submittal**, the following information is <u>required</u>:

- A brief (not to exceed one page) description of the project and why it is beneficial to the community
 - **OR** a report of the previous study that describes the submitted alternative in PDF format
- An identified local sponsor
- A GIS-based file of the project benefit area in .shp format. A Google Earth .kmz file is also acceptable.
- Hydrologic models (if applicable) and hydraulic models showing both existing conditions and post-project conditions of the desired alternative
- A cost estimate for the proposed project construction/implementation
- A benefit-cost analysis (BCA) for the alternative using either FEMA or TWDB BCA tools
- A certification (signed and sealed by an engineer) that the proposed project does not cause adverse impacts to any surrounding area

To support an FMP submittal, the following information is encouraged but not required:

• GIS-based floodplain shapefiles for the 10-year, 100-year, and 500-year floodplain
